






Opened in 1873 as an entertainment venue for Victorian London, Alexandra Palace has been at the centre of extraordinary events for over 150 years including the first regular television broadcast in 1936 by the BBC. Its rich history adorns the fabric of the building, providing a multi-location site for productions. The Palace has nine interlinking and flexible indoor spaces including the magnificent Great Hall, lofty ice rink and sensitively restored Victorian Theatre, surrounded by 196 acres of parkland overlooking all of London. 
