


LATER DOLLY WOULD DESCRIBE WHAT CAME NEXT:

> SHE ROSE 2000 FT, THAT'S SIX TIMES HIGHER OF THE BBC TOWER (103M) OR TWICE THE HEIGHT OF LONDON'S TALLEST BUILDING THE SHARD AT JUST OVER 1000FT TALL (309.6M).

HER ONLY FLYING TECHNOLOGY WAS A TINY SILVER ALTIMETER STRAPPED TO HER LEFT WRIST WITH WHICH SHE WOULD JUDGE THE RIGHT HEIGHT BEFORE JUMPING AND PULLING HER PARACHUTE OPEN.




